



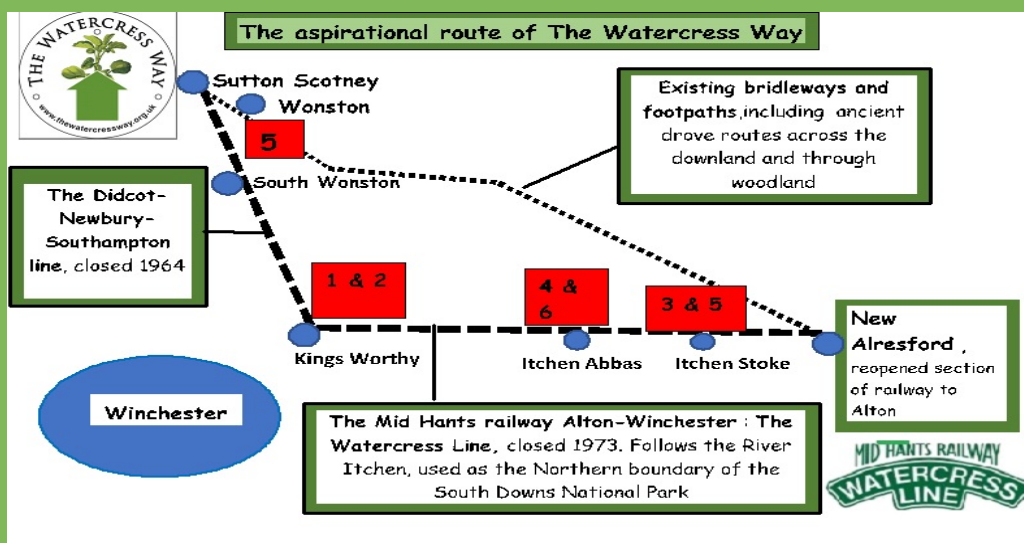
DAWN TO DUSK Activity Day
