### 1. Apologies –None

### 3a) To review and respond to SDNP Local Plan Proposals.

We had two landowners in attendance that would be affected by the Local Plan. The SDNP strategic plan has designated an area of garden owned jointly by the attending members of the public for 8 houses. The Clerk advised them to write to SDNP advising them of this fact.

28<sup>th</sup> October we should make representation on the Strategic Plan there are four main elements and four Councillors will prepare reports to be circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October.:-

Development Management Policy – Cllr Labram Spatula Plan – for the Western Downs – Cllr Denniss Settlement Boundaries – Cllr Appleby Allocation of housing – Cllr Riley.

Full Council will be asked for a response and each report will give a recommended response for Council's approval.

#### 2. To discuss and propose revised Planning Sub-Committee Terms of reference.

Clearly state that these are delegated powers.

Make them uniform

Other words were added or deleted and these will be circulated for adoption at the next Full council Meeting with the reports mentioned above.

### 3. To discuss and make recommendations on the scope of the planning elements within the Parish Plan to be adopted by Council.

Currently the council does not propose to produce s short design code this could Form part of a Neighbourhood Plan.

Statements with regard to smaller houses for downsizing etc. again should form part of a Neighbourhood Plan. As do comments regarding not allowing large extensions or conservatories on houses that have large plots. The Parish Plan dwelt on planning matters that were not within remit of a parish plan, and tried to justify planning decisions on that document. Council will be asked to make a deciosn on the advisability of producing a Neighbourhood Plan and all its time and financial obligations.

4. To discuss how to improve the councils responses to applications and gain a better understanding underpinning planning decision in WCC and SDNP.

The Clerk had written to Julie Pinnock and had a long conversation with a delegated officer to the end result, that WCC will not come to talk to Council and are not holding any training sessions this year,. Cllr Phillips had attended the last session and confirmed the Clerks report. The Clerk has asked that the response be in writing but to date it has not been forthcoming.

SDNP will be approached to ask if they will undertake planning training, via Tim Slaney Director of Planning whilst noting his postal address is that of Winchester City Council.

## 5. To consider the implications of the introduction of Community Infrastructure levy on future infrastructure plans.

SDNP will continue to use the 106b Land Development Agreement format until April 2016.

If we have a neighbourhood Plan we would be eligible for 25% of the levy if not 15%. SDNP have a kitty that can be applied to for schemes as they will retain 75% of the CIL.

Cllr Phillips remarked that one of the Rectory Lane plats have commenced building we are not sure if it is the self- build one or not.

### 6. To discuss the removal of saplings at The King George V playing fields at Couch Green.

This is not a planning matter. The committee agreed to accept the kind offer with thanks.

#### 7. Any Applications received to date.

Both Cllr Denniss & Cllr Appleby know the applicants but do not have a pecuniary interest in the application.
