At the time of the Parish Council Meeting on the 24/7 there were no documents available to view. It is because of this and due to the inadequacy of the previous submitted drawings, IVPC feels it has no choice but to object.
5. **Report on M3/A34 link meeting attending 12/07**



Cllr Appleby has made a complaint to Highways England as IVPC did not receive an invitation to the last Consultation Meeting, and that no meetings have been held in the Itchen Valley.

Cllr Appleby has been advised that the more people comment on the consultation in a personal capacity, the more the opinions will be listened to.

Cllr Appleby explained what the proposed new layout would look like and the possible negative effects on traffic crossing over from the A34 to the A33 from the second exit from Winnall Trading Estate roundabout. Join the traffic that is coming from the motorway, allowing 625m to cross over to the A33. The current proposed speed limit coming up from the M3 will be 60mph, thus allowing vehicles, by Cllr Appleby's calculation there would be only 23 seconds to cross over to the A33 which he felt could be dangerous.

There some discussion. it was resolved that Cllr Appleby to comment on behalf of IVPC, suggesting the use of space to construct a new lane which would branch off the proposed access road for northbound traffic onto the M3. The new lane would then run between the M3 access road and the northbound carriage way of A34 and link into the existing section of the A33 at a similar point where the A33 and A34 split at present. There would be access to the A34 from the Winnal roundabout but not from the proposed link onto the A33.

**6. Update on Woolie Fest**

Cllr Appleby had attempted to contact the bursar at Princes Mead but has yet to hear back. Cllr Appleby received a call from the resident who had the original concern and she appears happier now that she has received more details.

Cllr Appleby does not feel there is great cause for concern but will continue to try and contact bursar to get more information.
