**W970 – A31 Alresford Road (Rodfield Lane), Ovington – Carriageway
Resurfacing – High Friction Surface Treatment**

Following the recent carriageway resurfacing works on A31 Alresford Road **eastbound**, at its junction with Rodfield Lane and Ovington Park Lane, this is to advise you that we will be returning to install a new high friction surface treatment to complete the scheme.

This is programmed to start 17th September 2020 and are expected to last for up to 2 nights, during which time the **eastbound carriageway** between the Percy Hobbs and Lady Croft roundabouts will be closed to vehicular traffic, between the hours of 20:00hrs and 06:00hrs each night.

The above timescales are weather dependent, any significant changes to the scheduled dates will be made clear on the yellow sign boards located at the works limits.

Due to the current COVID-19 situation, works will be carried out ensuring safe working practices, and social distancing between site operatives and members of the public are maintained at all times. The appropriate traffic management will be in place to prevent any interaction.

For your safety and that of our workforce, if your property or business is located off of the **eastbound carriageway** we are unable to guarantee vehicular access during working hours.
In order to avoid potential injury or damage, please do not walk across the carriageway during the works unless directed by a member of the workforce.

Thank you for your co-operation and please accept my apologies for any inconvenience these works may cause you.
